RULES

1. Open competition is open to Virginia members and all other states. Junior competition is for (2011) Virginia Junior Holstein members only.
2. **Milk** – All milk must not contain any ANTIBIOTIC RESIDUE. Bucket milkers will be available at the milking parlor for use on treated cows.
3. **Stalls will be assigned.** Stall space not guaranteed for entries received after Mar.18 2011
4. Cattle will be accepted beginning **Thurs. MAR 30, at 8:00 A.M.** No cattle or tack may be put in barn before Thurs. **MAR 30, at 8:00 A.M.**
5. **All animals must be on the grounds by 6:00 P.M. Friday APR, 1**
6. **Entry deadline, March 18, 2011** (Received or Postmarked)
Entry Fee **\$5.00** per stall for Virginia members and paid by March 18, 2011.
Non member or out of state entry fee **\$7.00** per stall by March 18, 2011.
Entry Fee **\$20.00** per stall if received or postmarked after March 18, 2011.
You will be billed for the difference on entries received or postmarked after March 18, 2011.
Fees are for cattle and tack stalls. No refund of entry fee.
7. Show ring code of ethic approved by HFA will govern the show.
8. The show committee encourages each to adhere to the dress code.
9. All cows shown in Dry Cow Classes names and registration numbers will be reported to the state DHIA office.
10. Classes will be shown in the same order as listed.
11. At all time the decision of the show committee will be final.
12. Show harness will be required.
13. Registration and health papers will be checked.
14. **Health Regulations**
No animals shall be exhibited unless they are accompanied by a health certificate signed within 45 days of the show by a licensed Veterinarian showing that they are free from contagious or infections disease.

15. **REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES**

- A. Registration or Recorded certificates must accompany all animals. Animals 87%RHA and higher are eligible for the show.
- B. For animals purchased in 2011 bring proof of purchase or certificate. (Buyers copy of transfer, shipping chart, etc.)
- C. The registration certificate will be considered as proof of identity, parentage, birth date, ownership and breeder of animal.
- D. Registration certificate for all animals entered in any group class must be brought to the ring with the animal.
- E. All animals must be entered exactly as ownership appears on the registration certificate. Any certificates accompanied by a transfer or ownership form will be retained by show management and submitted to HFA for transfer. Transfer fee will be paid by the exhibitor.

PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR

Premier Exhibitor Award – shall be made to the exhibitor credited with the most points on not to exceed six animals owned and exhibited. In case of multiple ownership, all points awarded for Premier Exhibitor will be credited to the individual, partnership member, syndicate member or family unit that is exhibiting the animal.

Premier Breeder Award – shall be made to the breeder of animals credited with the most point on not to exceed six animals, exhibited by himself or other exhibitors. When determining the Premier Breeder the breeder of the animal shall be the name of the person, partnership or syndicate as it appears on the registry certificate.

Family Unit Defined – if a herd is registered in the names of the immediate members of a family these persons may combine their entries as a “family unit”, and be considered as one exhibitor for premier exhibitor point. In order to qualify as a “Family Unit”, all animals must be kept in the same herd.

PEE WEE SHOWING CLASS

For youth 5 to 8 years of age (as of the date of the summer show)

Must have an adult in show ring at all times

Youth showing in this class are not eligible to show in the novice class

This is not a competitive class

Participants will receive a ribbon

BEST UDDER AWARD

In each of the milking classes, the judge will select the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd best udder cows. This selection shall be made on the basis of udder alone and milk out will be at the discretion of the judge.

BEST BRED AND OWNED

A rosette will be given the Best Bred and Owned Animal in each of the senior female classes. The winner of each of these classes will compete for the best bred and owned award.

BEST BRED AND OWNED, YOUTH DIV.

A ribbon will be given the Best Bred and Owned Animal in each of the junior and senior female classes. The winners of each of these classes will compete for the best bred and owned award. This will be lead out class.

PRODUCTION AWARDS AMEVA FARM, INC. TROPHY

A ribbon will be awarded to the cow with the highest 305 day record or less (adjusted to 2X) in cow classes # 11, 12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20.

This is the best record regardless of which lactation the cow is now milking in.

Production records must be included on the entry blank to be considered for the ribbons and trophy. DHIA cow page copies must be sent with entries.

The Ameva Farm Trophy will be awarded to the cow with the highest overall production from the winners of the above mention classes.

VIRGINIA JUNIOR HOLSTEIN SHOW RULES

1. All Junior members must be a current member (paid in the current year) of the Virginia Junior Holstein Association. Dues may be paid at the Spring Show. Deadline for paying dues for the current year in order to be able to show at the Virginia Summer Holstein Show is May 1 of the current year. The parent (s) and/or guardian of the junior member must be a resident of the state of Virginia.

New members (Has never been a member of the Virginia Junior Holstein Assoc.) may show at the summer Holstein show, if they have paid their dues by the date of the summer Holstein show.

2. Eligibility: Participation in the spring and summer show is open to all Virginia Junior Holstein members who are 9 years of age as of the first Saturday in August (or day of state Holstein summer show) and not over 21 years of age as of December 31 of the current year.
3. Animals must be owned and registered in the junior member's name for the spring show. For the summer show the animal (s) must be owned and registered in the junior members name by **May 1** of the current year. The application for transfer must be **received by** Holstein Association USA on or before the deadline.
LEASED ANIMALS Rules for Leased animals.
Must be entered on an official entry form and received by March 18, 2011
Entry fees \$5.00 if received by March 18, 2011, \$20.00 if received or postmarked after March 18, 2011
Must attach a copy of your lease agreement with sponsor to your entry form.
Lease agreement must have: Date of Agreement, Signature of Owner (sponsor) Your Signature (Lessee) and Parents or guardian signature
4. To be eligible to participate as a junior member of the Virginia Junior Holstein Junior Show the animal must be shown by the owner who is a member of the Virginia Junior Holstein Association, except by prior written approval. If approved, another member of the Virginia Junior Holstein Association of similar age group (9-14) or (15-21). If the member has more than one animal in a class then another member of the Virginia Junior Holstein Association must show that animal. Request for approval of not showing an animal by the owner must be made to the Show Chairman 24 hours prior to the beginning of the show unless an emergency exists. The decision to grant approval will be made by the President of the Virginia Junior Holstein Association and the Show Chairman of the Virginia Holstein Association, Inc.
5. Junior syndicates will be allowed between junior members of the same family provided all are at least 9 years of age and under 21 years of age, as of December 31 of the current year. No adults are allowed in junior syndicates.
6. All animals shown in Fitting and Showing classes must be owned by the exhibitor.
7. The showing and fitting classes will be divided into four divisions:
NOVICE - those who are showing for the first year. Exhibitor may have shown at a previous show during this calendar year, but not previous to this year. JUNIOR - 9 to 12 years of age as of the first Saturday in August of current year INTERMEDIATE - 13 to 15 years of age as of the first Saturday in August of the current year SENIOR - 16 to 21 years of age as of December 31 of the current year

The judge will be instructed to consider the following scorecard:

Appearance of animal	20 points
Appearance of exhibitor	10 points
Presentation of the animal in the ring	70 point
Total	100 points

8. It is not necessary to "bag" cows for the fitting and showing contest. The judge will be so instructed.

12. **DRY FIVE AND OLDER COW** –Born prior to Sept 1, 2006
2011 FUTURITY FOR THREE YEAR OLD COWS – SUMMER SHOW ONLY – Born Sept 1, 2007 thru Aug 31, 2008
14. **JUNIOR TWO YEAR OLD COW** – (not necessarily in milk) – Born Mar 1, 2009 thru Aug 31, 2009
15. **SENIOR TWO YEAR OLD COW** – Born Sept 1, 2008 thru Feb 28, 2009
16. **JUNIOR THREE YEAR OLD COW** – Born Mar 1, 2008 thru Aug 31, 2008
17. **SENIOR THREE YEAR OLD COW** –Born Sept 1, 2007 thru Feb 28, 2008
18. **FOUR YEAR OLD COW** – Born Sept 1, 2006 thru Aug 31, 2007
19. **FIVE YEAR OLD COW** – Born Sept. 1, 2005 thru Aug 31, 2006
20. **AGED COW** -Born prior to Sept 1, 2005
21. **100,000 COW** -Cows any age that have produced 100,000 lbs of milk on DHIA or Tri Star test. Verification on production must available at check in . NOTE; Animal may be exhibited in either individual age class or the 100,000 lbs. Class, NOT BOTH and must be determined at check in time.
22. **SENIOR CHAMPION FEMALE** – (Open and Youth Division)
23. **RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION FEMALE** – (Open and Youth Division)
24. **GRAND CHAMPION OF SHOW** – (Open and Youth Division)
25. **RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION OF SHOW** – (Open and Youth Division)

28. **DAM AND DAUGHTER** -To consist of two females, one to be the offspring of the other, May be owned by two exhibitors.
29. **PRODUCE OF DAM** -To consist of two animals any age, the produce of one cow, May be owned by two exhibitors.
30. **BEST THREE FEMALES** - To consist of three females, any age all bred by and carrying the exhibitor's prefix. One animal may be owned by another exhibitor.
31. **BREEDERS HERD** - To consist of five animals, all females, all owned by exhibitor. All must be bred by and owned by the exhibitor. There shall be two under, 2 years of age, two over 2 years of age that have calved and one any age.
